HOW TO STOP UNWANTED CALLS ON MOBILE PHONES

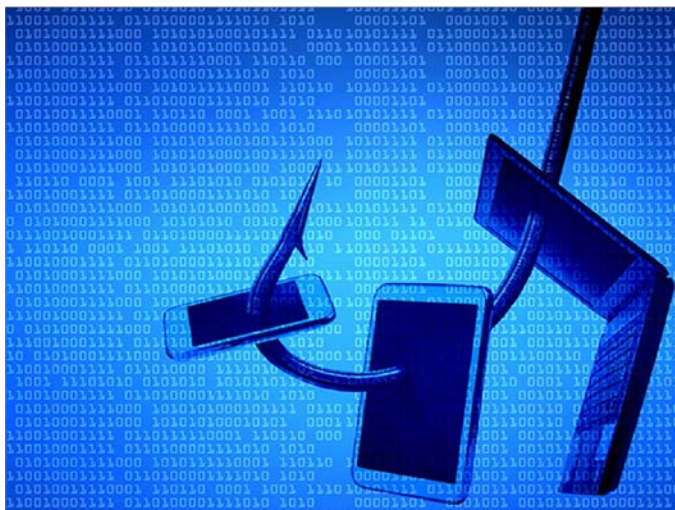
- Consider “low-tech” solutions like keeping your contacts up-to-date
- Block suspected scam numbers in your settings
- Download call-blocking apps:
 - Changing apps regularly may be more effective
 - Some apps are free, and others charge fees
 - Some legitimate calls may be blocked

HOW TO STOP UNWANTED CALLS ON A LANDLINE

- Contact your carrier and see what services are available
- Some services are free, but others charge a monthly fee
- Install a call-blocking device to:
 - stop unwanted calls
 - divert calls to voicemail
- Ask your carrier if they offer Voice over Internet Protocol (VoIP) call blocking solutions
 - With VoIP blocking solutions, calls might be stopped, ring silently, or go straight to voicemail

Don't assume your caller ID identifies who is calling.
Scammers can make it look like they're calling from a company
or number you trust.
