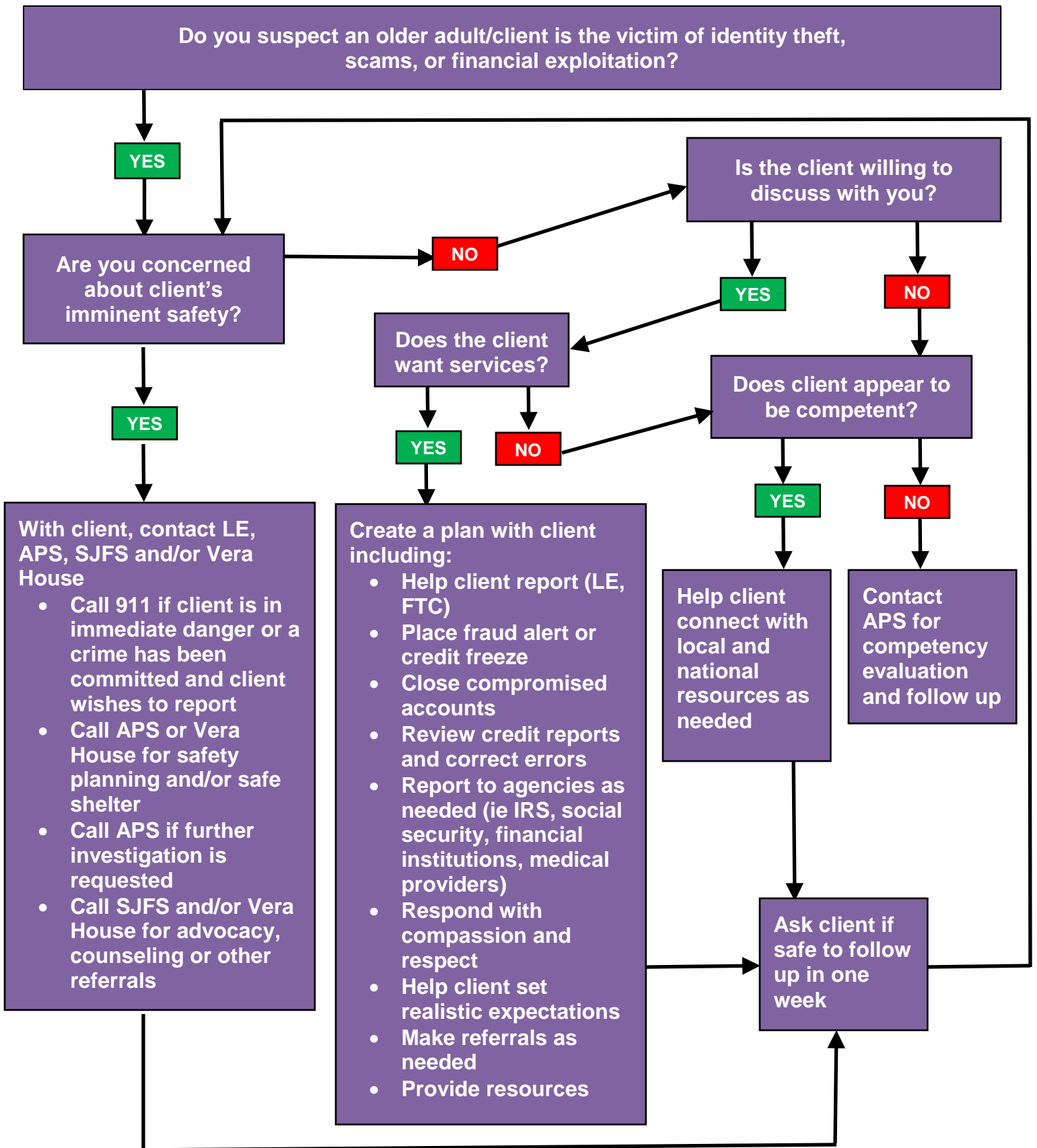


Identity Theft and Scams Decision Tree

Educate client about identity theft, scams, and financial exploitation. Facilitate referrals as needed. Consider:

- Law Enforcement: if crime was committed and client wishes to report.
- Adult Protective Services: further investigation, community supports, guardianship.
- Doctor: physical, cognitive, or mental health concerns.
- Attorney: evictions, Power of Attorney, etc.
- Vera House: advocacy, counseling, referrals, after-hours and weekend support.
- Syracuse Jewish Family Service: counseling and advocacy if cognitive concerns.
- Office for Aging: community resources.
- Maintain contact and supportive relationship with client if client agrees.
